School rules

1. International Students who attend Rangiora New Life School are subject to the same school rules as all other Rangiora New Life students.
2. Rude or rebellious behaviour will not be accepted.
3. International students wishing to drive in New Zealand must apply to the school for permission. See "Driving & Car Ownership" on page 17 of the International Students Handbook.
4. Students must not be passengers in vehicles traveling to and from school, unless they have gained written permission from the Principal.
5. In accordance with New Zealand law all road rules must be obeyed, including the wearing of safety belts in motor vehicles and safety helmets on bicycles.
6. Valuable items such as compact disc players, etc are not to be brought to school. Jewellery, other than that allowed in the uniform code, is not to be worn. Sums of money should not be left in lockers.
7. Smoking is not permitted on the school premises at any time. Students are not permitted to bring cigarettes to school. Smoking at any time in school uniform is not permitted.
8. No alcoholic liquor is permitted on the school premises at any time. Students who bring alcohol to school, who have it in their possession, or who consume it, will be disciplined. Students are also not permitted to consume alcohol prior to coming to school functions such as dinners, dances and sporting events, or any organised functions following school events. The school authorities will also take a serious view of students being involved with liquor outside school.
9. No illegal drugs are permitted on the school premises at any time. The school authorities will also take a very serious view of students being involved with illegal drugs outside school.
10. Boy-girl relationships: there is to be no physical contact between boys and girls. Where a natural interest develops it must be conducted so as not to be conspicuous or exclusive.
11. Where established procedures exist for smooth and orderly running of the school, these must be followed.
12. Regulation school uniform is to be worn correctly and as required.
13. Hairstyles must be neat, clean and tidy. Extreme styles are not acceptable.
14. Make-up is not to be worn with school uniform.
15. Students must abide by the laws of New Zealand.
16. Students must obey contracted caregiver and homestay parent rules.
17. Students must always be aware of their responsibility as an international student and make a determined effort in school.
18. Students must not leave the school grounds during school hours without permission from the principal.
19. Students must attend all school classes daily and complete all homework and assignments. Repeated unexplained absences may result in the student's dismissal from the school.
20. If Students travel home by bus or van then they must come to the office if they miss their bus or van and wait until arrangements can be made for them to be picked up. If an International Student wants to go to someplace different after school they should let the office know and have a note from their Homestay parents
21. Students are not permitted to work for money if on a Student Visa. IMMIGRATION: "Full details of visa and permit requirements, advice on rights to employment in New Zealand while studying, and reporting requirements are available through the New Zealand Immigration Service, and can be viewed on their website at www.immigration.govt.nz".
22. Natural parents or the student's agent will be consulted on any major problem, but the final decision with regard to dismissal from Rangiora New Life School will be the Principal's responsibility. Refer to the Rangiora New Life School Behaviour Code, Discipline System and Grievance Procedures, for grievance procedures. If you require a copy of the Rangiora New Life School Behaviour Code, Discipline System and Grievance Procedure or Ministry of Education Appeal Authority Booklet, please request one from the International College office.
23. Students are to comply with the reasonable instructions of the school.
24. Students and agents must advise the school office of any change of New Zealand home address or phone number.
25. Students must respect the school term dates. All holiday travel must be within school holiday time only, unless permission is gained from the Principal.
26. The student acknowledges that the school may from time to time amend or add to these Rules in the interests of the school and the student, and the student is bound by such amendments.
